School Supply Drive and Distribution

In August before school starts, the United Way School Supply Drive and Distribution provides area students with a backpack and basic school supplies. Kids start school ready to learn and achieve their potential. In 2011 the School Supply Drive and Distribution prepared 347 children in 105 families with the necessary basic supplies to begin their school year.



Day of Caring

Day of Caring is a mobilization of volunteers who celebrate the spirit of giving through service. In 2010 we had 200 volunteers that assisted 46 folks with project in their home.

Day of Caring volunteers are assigned to assist elderly and homebound residents with projects such as painting a room, cleaning out flowerbeds or sorting canned food. No matter what your interest or skills, there is an opportunity for you to get involved.
